


Preschool Field Trip: A Journey to Godong Ijo



Preschool field trip play an essential role in a child's early education, offering hands-on learning experiences opportunities to connect with the world around them. A trip to Godong Ijo, Sawangan proves to be an ideal destination for young learners, offering both fun and educational activities in a unique, nature-filled environment. For Preschoolers, this venue presents a fantastic opportunity to interact with nature and learn about plants, animals, and the environment. The vibrant green landscape is ideal for introducing children to the wonders of the natural world while fostering their curiosity and appreciation for the environment.

The Field Trip Highlights:

1. Nature Walks and Eco-Learning:

The children are guided on a nature walk, where they can explore the rich flora and fauna of the area.

Educators teach them about the different types of plants, trees, and flowers found in Godong Ijo.

Children can feed farm animals like turtles, fishes which provides a hands-on experience and teaches them responsibility and empathy. Interacting with animals also introduces kids to the concepts of animal care, the role of animals in our world, and how to treat them respectfully.





2. Outdoor Play and Adventure:

The lush green fields and natural playgrounds allow for plenty of outdoor activities. Preschoolers can run, jump, and play in open spaces, encouraging physical development, motor skills, and social interaction.

3. Hands-on Crafts:

Another educational feature of the excursion is the chance to participate in workshops where children can create crafts using materials provided. This encourages creativity and artistic expression while connecting them to the natural world. It also provides an opportunity to practice fine motor skills as they create unique projects.



Primary Field Trip: "Move Actively & Think Creatively."



On 10-11 October 2024, Primary students of Sophos School Indonesia participated in a field trip themed "Move Actively & Think Creatively." This activity aimed to provide an interactive and enjoyable learning experience outside the classroom while encouraging students to stay active and think creatively.

The field trip destinations were BXsea and TransSnow World, two educational and recreational locations offering a variety of engaging activities.

Enhancing motor skills and creativity:

Through various physical activities and interactive games, children were able to develop their motor skills and sharpen their imagination.

- 1. Learning through hands-on experiences: Students were invited to explore and experiment with new concepts in a practical setting.
- 2. Improving motor skills: A range of games encouraged active movement among students.

The first series of activities took place at BXsea, a marine-themed educational facility designed to provide insights into marine life. The activities conducted included:

Aquarium Educational Tour:

The children were guided to observe various marine creatures, including tropical fish, jellyfish, and coral reefs. They were also provided with explanations about marine ecosystems and the importance of preserving the marine environment.





Marine-Themed Interactive Games:

The children participated in educational games, such as "Guess the Fish Name," designed to enhance their understanding of marine life. The children participated in a dedicated crafting session focused on creating fish-shaped models at BXsea.

Fish Feeding Observation Activity:

Activities at TransSnow World

The second series of activities took place at TransSnow World, where children enjoyed an exciting and educational experience playing in the snow. The activities included:

Snow Play: Children are playing in a manmade snow area, trying to create various shapes from the snow and playing snowball fights. This activity helps develop physical coordination and provides a unique experience

Snow Sliding: The children experienced sliding on the snow, an activity designed to develop their balance and boost their confidence. Under guided supervision, they enjoyed the thrill of gliding down snowy slopes while learning to navigate and control their movements.





Science Class:

The children participated in a hands-on science class where they learned about simple experiments demonstrating the changes in the states of matter. This engaging activity allowed them to explore scientific concepts in a fun and interactive way, deepening their understanding of how substances can transition between solid, liquid, and gas forms.

By conducting the experiments directly, the children were able to see the changes in matter with their own eyes, making science feel real and exciting. This hands-on approach allowed them to understand the concepts better, as they could experience the experiments themselves rather than just hearing about them. Secondary Excursion 2024: Exploring West Java



From 5-7 November 2024, our students embarked on the Secondary Excursion 2024, themed "Exploring West Java." This overland journey took them to three captivating cities: Purwakarta, Kuningan, and Cirebon. Not only was it an exciting adventure, but the excursion also offered educational experiences enriched with art and culture.

Purwakarta:

Traces of History and Creativity

Purwakarta was the first destination of the journey. This city boasts a rich tapestry of history and culture. At Bale Panyawangan, students explored the origins of Purwakarta and its historical struggles against the VOC (Dutch East India Company). The interactive exhibits brought history to life, making the learning experience engaging and memorable.



No trip to Purwakarta is complete without visiting the Plered Pottery Center. This hub showcases the region's artistic prowess in pottery. Students observed the intricate process of crafting pottery and even tried their hand at creating their own pieces—a unique activity that fostered creativity and appreciation for local artistry.



Kuningan: Cultural Harmony and Togetherness

The second day centered on Kuningan, often referred to as the "City of Horses." This city offered a deeper cultural immersion. In the morning, students participated in an angklung workshop, where they learned the basics of playing this traditional musical instrument. Guided by skilled instructors, they also discovered the philosophy of teamwork embodied in angklung music.

The afternoon featured a fun outing and amazing race at Woodland Kuningan. Amidst lush greenery, students worked in teams to overcome various challenges that combined physical activities, strategic thinking, and team bonding. The activity was both exhilarating and a great way to strengthen friendships.

In the evening, participants were treated to a spectacular Topeng Dance Performance during dinner at the hotel. Every movement in this traditional mask dance carried rich stories and profound philosophies, offering students a deeper understanding of Kuningan's cultural identity.







The masks, or Topeng, represent different characters, emotions, and moral values. Each mask carries a specific symbolism, such as wisdom, greed, or virtue. The graceful movements the dancers. of accompanied by gamelan music. stories timeless of human behavior. spirituality, and philosophy. Witnessing this performance allowed students to connect with a historical art form that continues to thrive in modern Indonesia.

Cirebon: Immersing in Tradition and Heritage

On the journey home, the group made a stop in Cirebon, a city renowned for its coastal cultural heritage. The first destination was the Keraton Kasepuhan, the grand palace of the Cirebon Sultanate. Students toured this majestic site and learned about the blend of local, Islamic, and colonial architectural styles that make the palace unique.



The next stop was Batik Trusmi, a famous batik production center in Cirebon. Here, students observed the intricate process of batik-making, from drawing patterns to dyeing fabrics. They even tried their hand at batik, making it a fun and educational experience.

Preschool Exhibition and The Peak of Term 2 Family Project


The whole week's event was closed by The Preschool Exhibition and The Peak Celebration of Term 2 Family Project on Friday, 5 December 2024.
